Dear Mr. Raglin

I have just received
notice that your son was a
member of the crew on the
forties that my son was
left ward gunner which
went down was the crew
of the Plasteros oil fields
of Plasteros April 24th.

I know the navigator
that left the states with
the boys was lost on his
first mission and I did
not know before what had
happened to him.

My son is reported killed
and I would like to know
if you would like to know
